Hello Educators,

Can you think of an activity that combines science, mathematics, technology and engineering with aerodynamics, history and art? Plus, it gets the children outside, playing in the sun!

The answer is... kite building and kite flying!

We are now booking classroom visits for the 2017 / 2018 spring season and would love to come to your school. This year we will be teaching several different kite patterns and all of them fly extremely well. We make sure that every child has a successful experience with our program.

This year we will make a bird kite, a cellular kite or a delta kite. Building each of them involves learning basic skills that children need to succeed in life. Measuring, paying attention, helping others, knot tying, creative thinking, following instructions, being persistent and developing patience are a few of the benefits of kite building and kite flying. Children learn how kites ushered in the aviation era, how they've been used for 2,000 years, how dihedrals make flying possible, and how innovative materials make unusual kites possible. Lift, drag, resistance and balance are all covered.

Our kites work well for children in the 4th, 5th and 6th grades. Our program is two hours long, which allows for half an hour of flying time. Two of us come to your school so we can teach a total of six classes in a day. For a classroom of 25 to 30 children, we will need the teacher and one parent assistant to help us.

We also will bring the "Flying Buffalo Project" kites, featuring art created by well-known Native American artists. This beautiful collection has been flown at protected buffalo jump sites in America and Canada and featured in many magazine and television stories. The kite art tells the story about how important the buffalo was to the Native American people and how the animals were harvested before the arrival of horses. We encourage schools to combine our education program with special family days going on in your area and use our buffalo kite flying as an outreach event to connect with your community.

Contact me for more information about this program that has received rave reviews from schools across our nation. Workshop prices are extremely reasonable and we offer scholarships for all children that need financial assistance. We only have 30 teaching days available and always fill up, so if you are interested in having us visit your school please get in touch with me as soon as possible.
